Students entering Law School before Fall 2016 must successfully complete 3 Practical Skills credit hours. Students entering Fall 2016 or later must complete 6 Practical Skills credit hours. When a course qualifies under both criteria, students entering Fall 2016 or later may use the same course to meet the Capstone Writing Requirement and the Practical Skills Requirement. Students may not use their qualifying 2L Writing Requirement course to meet the Practical Skills Requirement.
