Payment Procedures for Georgia Law Summer Program in China

Tuition and applicable fees will be billed directly through the online UGA Student Accounts System. Once you have submitted this application, a student account will be set up in your name. All payments will be made online except the application fee (see below). ***Full payment of tuition and all applicable fees is due no later than April 30, 2012.*** Each student is responsible for checking his/her student account and making payments in a timely manner.

If a student withdraws voluntarily from the program, he or she is responsible for paying any unrecoverable program costs. If a student is dismissed from the program for academic or conduct reasons after the program begins, there will be no credits issued to the student accounts for fees that have been charged to the account. If the program is cancelled due to insufficient student enrollment, then all charges will be removed.

Summary of Fees

- **Non-refundable program application fee (\$250):** Send a check for the \$250 non-refundable application fee to: Bursar's Office, University of Georgia, 424 E. Broad St., Athens, GA 30602 immediately ***upon email notification of receipt of your application.*** The check should be made payable to: *University of Georgia*, with "Georgia Law Summer Program in China" in the memo line.

- **Technology, green fee, and institutional fees** (these cannot be waived for study abroad); see the web site above for fee amounts.
- **Georgia Law Summer Program in China program fee.**
- **Out-of-state Board of Regent's Fee (\$250).** *This fee is waived for Georgia residents, whatever home university they attend. It is also waived for students enrolled at University System of Georgia schools and SEC member institutions, regardless of state of residence.*

Note: *Exchange rate fluctuation and/or inflationary conditions may necessitate that the program raise fees above previously advertised rates between the time of admission and the beginning of the program.*
