All students pay regular tuition and a program fee. The program fee of the 2017 program is \$6,700. This fee covers housing costs (including utilities), the cost of U.K. instructors, the on-site British coordinator, library privileges, affiliation with St. Anne's, ABA fees and other administrative expenses. Food, transportation, and other personal expenses are not included. A mandatory deposit fee of \$200 is due after you have accepted admission to the program, in order to hold your place. Of this deposit, \$100 is refundable if you withdraw from the program by July 29, 2016. A second deposit of \$1,300 is due by August 2, 2016. The balance of the program fee will be due on our about December 15, 2016. Amounts paid beyond the \$200 deposit are not refundable, except in emergency situations. The University of Georgia School of Law reserves the right to cancel this program in the event of compelling circumstances. All monies, including the initial \$200 deposit, would in such event be returned within 20 days of the date of cancellation and the law school will make its best efforts to arrange for the student to attend a similar program, if the student wishes, and to the extent feasible.
